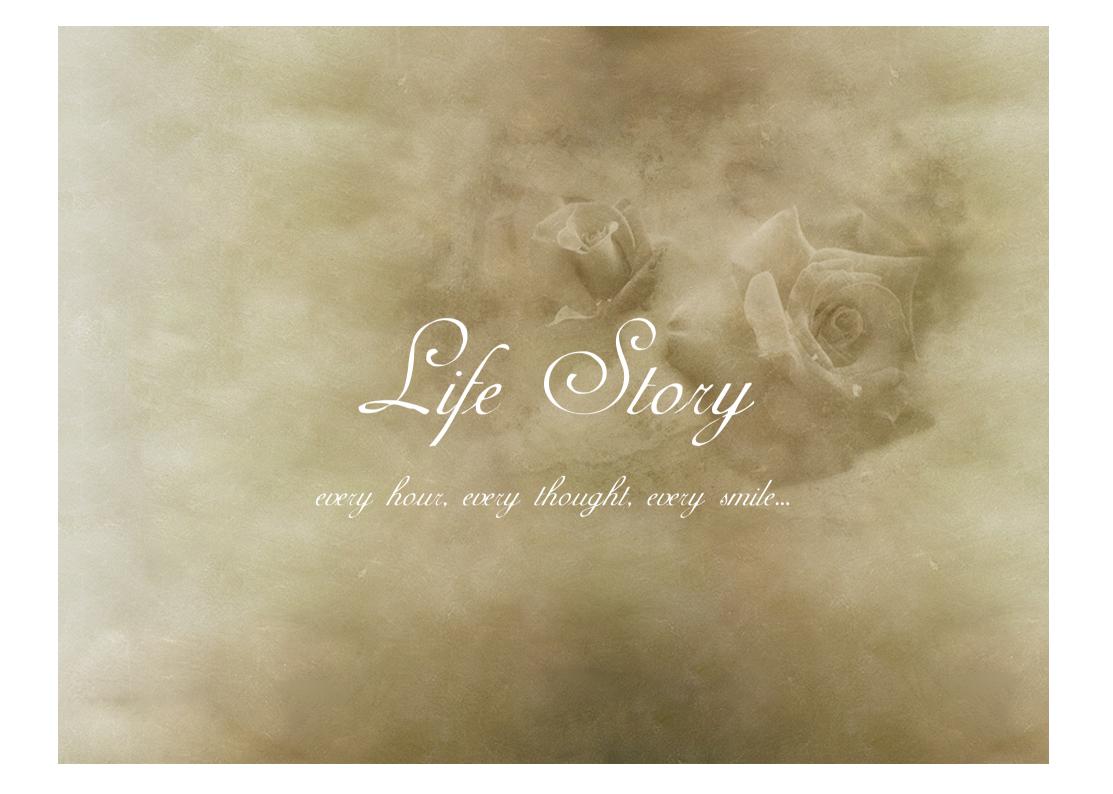


I will never forget the first time Mum saw Maisie and how she looked when she saw me with my daughter.
